# SIGNATURE INSTRUCTIONS

Please take the following actions:

- Print each document on single-sided pages. **Check your printer settings and printed forms to make sure the full form is visible when printed, including the edition date in the lower left corner and the barcode (where applicable).**
- Carefully review each document for accuracy and notify us if anything needs to be revised.
- If the documents meet with your approval, sign and date them in blue ink as instructed below:

**Form G-28 Notice of Attorney Representative\***

Print and sign **THREE** of these forms for each applicant. Sign and date on page 3 in Part 4 (questions 2.a. and 2.b.).

*\*We request three (3) signed G-28 forms for each applicant to accompany their I-485, I-131 and I-765 applications. Note that Form I-485 Supplement J is a supplementary form and does not require an additional signed G-28 form.*

**Form I-485 Application to Register Permanent Residence or Adjust Status**

Sign and date on page 22 in Part 10 (question 4).

**Form I-485 Supplement J Confirmation of Bona Fide Job Offer (enclosed if applicable)**

Sign and date on page 2 in Part 3 (question 4). Required for the principal applicant only.

**Form I-131 Application for Advance Parole**

Sign and date on page 11 in the "Signature of Applicant" section.

**Form I-765 Application for Employment Authorization**

Sign and date on page 4 in Part 3 (questions 7.a. and 7.b.)

**Children ages 14 and older** are required to sign their own application. Children under the age of 14 may have a parent sign on their behalf. If the parent signs his or her own name on applications for children under the age of 14, please write "on behalf of \_Child's name\_" next to the signature.

**Please send us the signed documents as soon as possible. Once we receive all the signed documents, we will finalize the application for filing with U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).**
